# Welcome to The Log Cabin Charity

At The Log Cabin Charity, we believe every child deserves a place to play, grow, and feel safe. Based in Ealing, we provide high-quality play and support services for children and young people with additional needs and disabilities.

We offer a welcoming and inclusive space where families feel supported, and children and young people with SEND can play and socialise alongside their mainstream peers, building friendships and learning from each other in a nurturing environment. Our trained staff provide support tailored to each child's needs.

We are equipped with accessible facilities such as a sensory room, soft play areas, a large outdoor playground, and quiet spaces to support emotional regulation and wellbeing. These resources help us create a safe and engaging environment where children can explore, develop new skills, and enjoy meaningful play.

## Our Services

### After School Club (Ages 5–15)

*Term Time | Monday to Friday | 3:00–6:30pm*

- Fun, engaging activities tailored to your child's needs according to their personalised plan
- Walking escorts/minibus pick-up from local schools (subject to availability)
- Local school collections – Little Ealing, Grange, Fielding and Mount Carmel Primary School
- Light refreshments provided



### Holiday Playschemes (Ages 5–15)

*School Holidays, Half Terms, Easter and Summer, excludes Bank Holidays | Monday to Friday | 9:30am–3:30pm*

- Organised outings into the community, including local parks, museums etc
- Themed events and activities
- Packed lunch is required

### Saturday Club (Ages 5–15)

*Term Time | Saturdays | 9:30am–1:30pm and 2:00–6:00pm*

- A fun weekend break with games, creative play, and social time

### Stay2gether Sessions (Under 12s, with family)

*Twice a month | Sundays | 10:00am–1:00pm*

- Inclusive sessions for all children and their families.
- A chance for parents to relax, connect and play with their children
- Sensory and play-based activities in a safe, relaxed setting, with different themed zones arranged for each session, such as arts and crafts, gardening, soft play, and cooking, tailored to various developmental needs
- Parents can share experiences, build informal peer support networks, and strengthen ties within the community
- A diverse range of engaging activities, including sensory play, arts and crafts, cooking, gardening, soft play, and themed days
- Activities to build confidence, communication, and teamwork
